IGIP Pinewood Derby Rules

In an effort to promote fair play, the Longhouse would like to publicize some rules to clarify any misconceptions regarding the IGIP's pinewood derby races.

Cars

The cars shall be constructed only from the kit provided, which includes the wood block, axles, wheels and wheel clips. The axles and wheels cannot be filed, shortened or altered other than polished as described in the directions. The front and rear axle slots are not to be changed or altered in any way, including relocating in block or cutting the slots deeper.

Weights can be added to the car to bring the weight to **5.0oz** as measured by the check-in scale. Decorative pieces can be added but the height cannot exceed **2 and 3/4 inches** and the width cannot extend beyond the wheelbase. Lubricants can be added as per instructions.

Cars purchased from other sources are not eligible for prizes as this practice is not in following with the intent of the program's goals. A new car must be made each year.

A lighted track determines heat winners but will be aided by judges selected by the longhouse. Judges decisions are final. Judges will excuse themselves in events when their child is involved.
